Safety

Read all individual component owners manuals and chemical instructions to ensure chemical compatibility as well as component specific safety issues.

- 1.) Do not spray flammable fluids through the spray system.
- 2.) Do not point a spray gun at a person or in any direction other than the target.
- 3.) Do not use sprayer to transport potable water for human or livestock consumption.
- 4.) Do not spray if wind is strong enough to carry the spray material beyond it's target area.
- 5.) Do not allow riders on the sprayer.
- 6.) Do not allow children to operate the equipment.
- 7.) Keep children and pets away from the areas of operation.
- 8.) Do not transport the sprayer over steep or rough terrain which could cause rollover.
- 9.) Before towing or installing the sprayer make sure the vehicle's load ratings are sufficient to hold or tow the weight of the sprayer when tank is full.
- 10.) Always wear recommended safety clothing, (eye wear, respirators, gloves, etc.).*
- 11.) Always check for chemical compatibility of spray materials prior to use in your PBM Sprayer.*
- 12.) Always check the condition of the sprayer prior to operating. Check for loose bolts, nuts, fuel spills or leakage, flammable debris on or around engine exhaust.
